#### **Training Requirements for New Animal Users**

To access trainings, go to the <u>UC Learning Center</u> (<a href="http://training.ucsf.edu/">http://training.ucsf.edu/</a>) and log in using your UCSF MyAccess ID. To find a course, type "IACUC" or the course titles listed below in the search box to locate tutorials and hands-on training enrollment.

# **Step 1: Online Requirements:**

- <u>BRER I</u> (Required for all personnel listed on an IACUC protocol, regardless of role), <u>BRER II</u>, (Required if working with anesthetic agents and/or performing surgery and/or post-surgical care), and <u>BRER III</u> (Required for all personnel listed on an IACUC protocol that includes rodent survival surgery, regardless of role). Test-outs for BRER I and BRER II are available (BRER I Test-out and BRER II Test-out).
- Cage Density Policy Training (Required if assisting with breeding and/or colony management)
- MHS Questionnaire located at <a href="https://medicalhealthscreeningforanimalallergies.ucsfmedicalcenter.org/">https://medicalhealthscreeningforanimalallergies.ucsfmedicalcenter.org/</a> (Login using your MyAccess [SFXXXXXX] login or your work VPN login)

## Step 2: Hands-On Species-Specific Training:

## Mouse or rat users with less than one year of hands-on experience:

- Mouse Basic Handling (class includes: A virtual Session 1 & In-Person Session 2)
- Rat Basic Handling (class includes: A virtual Session 1 & In-Person Session 2)
- NOTE: It is NOT NECESSARY to register for euthanasia training in addition to basic handling training.

#### Mouse or rat users with greater than one year of hands-on experience:

- Mouse Euthanasia Training
- Rat Euthanasia Training
